She donated a crucifix from Nicaragua used during her mission work in that country. This crucifix will hang in the Art Room, 218, with a plaque acknowledging the donation and country of origin.

Any alumni and parents wishing to contribute to the collection may do so at any time. When determining if the crucifix is appropriate for our classroom collection, consider the following specifications:

- The crucified body of Christ
- Minimum height of 16"
