

Rates

Tuition

Tuition rates are established each year by the Board of Trustees. Tuition for the 2009-2010 school year is \$9,300 per student, subject to the discounts, subsidies and scholarships approved by the Board.

Fees

Registration Fee is \$300 per student and is due at the time of course selection.

Book Rental Fee of \$350 is due July 1st.

Building Fee of \$400 is due June 1st.

Graduation Fee of \$200 is due August 1st (seniors only).

No course fees, lab fees, general activity fees or technology fees are assessed.

Learning Center

The Learning Center program provides resource support to college-bound students with mild learning or attention issues. The program is supervised by a certified learning specialist to create successful independent learners. The Learning Center Supplement is \$3,250 per year. Discounts

Catholic Students who have been fully accepted into the Catholic Church through the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation are provided a \$750 tuition discount per student per year.

Parish Support Chaminade-Madonna will apply 100% of a family's total financial support of their Catholic parish toward the cost of tuition, up to a maximum of \$2,500 total per student per year. *(Cannot be used in conjunction with Catholic discount; tax receipt required.)*

Sibling Families with more than one student are entitled to a \$500 discount for the second child and each subsequent child. Children do not need to attend CM at the same time

Alumni / Marianist Parents who are graduates of Chaminade High School, Madonna Academy, Chaminade-Madonna or any Marianist high school or university are entitled to a \$500 discount per student. Confirmation from other school is required.

Catholic Church Employee

Families with one or more parent currently working full-time for the Catholic Church (school, church, etc.) are entitled to a \$500 discount per child per year. *(Proof of employment is required.)*

Payment Plans

Tuition is due on August 1st. Payment in full is appreciated, and the following payment plans are available:

- Ten (10) monthly automatic withdrawals from your checking or savings accounts (ACH transactions) on the first or fifth day of the month, from August to May.
- Twenty-two (22) bi-weekly ACH transactions, starting on either the first or second Friday of August and continuing every other week through the end of May.
- Monthly invoices will be mailed and cash, check or credit card is accepted.

Refunds

The expenses of the school are determined annually based upon student enrollment, and will not decrease if a student withdraws from Chaminade-Madonna; therefore no refunds are granted after August 1st.

Financial Aid

Keeping Catholic education affordable is critical to the mission of Chaminade-Madonna, and each year a financial aid budget is established to help families meet the cost of education. Direct contributions, fund-raisers, profits from the cafeteria and bookstore, and earnings from the C-M Endowment Fund are pooled together and awarded to families with demonstrated financial need. Academic achievement, disciplinary record and extracurricular participation are considered in the allocation of financial aid. Approximately 25% of C-M families receive financial aid.

Scholarships

Chaminade-Madonna established the Top Ten Scholarship program to reward the top ten students based on academic achievement in each class each year. Awards vary by grade and by year.
