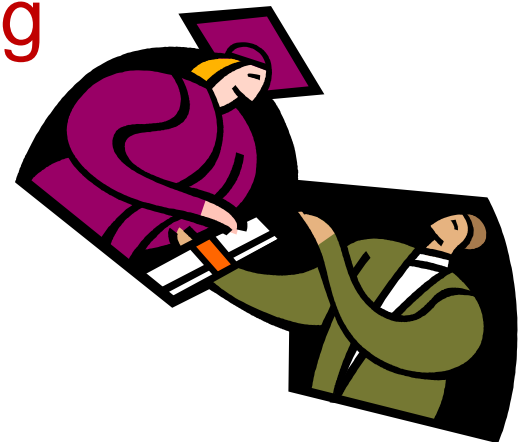

# What is Dual Enrollment?

- Dual Enrollment Program provides qualified high school sophomores, juniors and seniors the opportunity to take college-level courses at their schools, without disrupting their normal class schedule.
- These classes count for both high school and college credit.
- Most courses are \$180 (3 credit courses) and \$240 for 4 credit courses (Biology/Anatomy)

# Who is eligible for Dual Enrollment?

- Students qualify for admission to the Dual Enrollment program when they are taking a dual enrollment course (eligible high school Honors/AP courses)- The list of courses is included in later slide.
- Students have a **3.0 or better** simple/unweighted Cumulative GPA.

# How do I apply?

- NEW students to dual enrollment will need apply online at: [www.stu.edu/dualapplication](http://www.stu.edu/dualapplication)  
**Deadline to apply is Friday, September 17.**
- Once the student applies to St. Thomas University, they will receive a confirmation e-mail with instructions on how to retrieve their username and password within 48 hrs. This information is needed to register for courses.

# How do I register for Dual Enrollment Courses?

- Complete the Acknowledgement/Authorization Form(Registration form) found at the bottom of the page in the link provided:

- (Use the St. Thomas course codes from next slide to complete the Acknowledgement/Authorization Form)
- Your St. Thomas ID is the numbers in your username (for example, J569321--- the ID will be just the numbers and not the letter J)
  - If you don't know your unweighted GPA, leave it blank and Mrs. Echemendia will fill it out before submitting the form to St. Thomas University.
- Once you have completed the Registration Form, submit to your any of your dual enrollment teachers or to Mrs. Echemendia at [rechemendia@cmlions.org](mailto:rechemendia@cmlions.org) or turn in to the Main Office.
  - Deadline to register for courses is **Friday, September 24, 2021.**

## What is the cost and how do I make the payment?

- \$180 for 3 credit courses
- \$240 for 4 credit courses

**Making a Payment: (Deadline is October 22, 2021)**

### **Payment Method #1**

1. Go to <https://go.stu.edu/pay>
2. Fill out the form. Please make sure to add STU ID# or SS# and select “Dual Enrollment” for the “What is this payment for?” option. Once completed, click SUBMIT.

### **Payment Method #1:**

1. Go to <https://bobcat.stu.edu> & login (you will need your St. Thomas Username and Password)
2. Under “WebAdvisor” folder click on the Students Tab, then Select the “Business Office” tab.
3. Select “Make a Payment” and then select “Pay on My Account.”
4. Review your balance and add the amount to be paid
5. Select your Payment Type, click SUBMIT & fill out payment information on the next window

**\*Florida Prepaid can be used to pay for Dual Enrollment Courses as long as your account is paid in full. (email Mrs. Echemendia ([rechemendia@cmlions.org](mailto:rechemendia@cmlions.org)) and she will send you the Florid Prepaid Form to be sent as payment).**



## What are the benefits of enrolling in St. Thomas University's Dual Enrollment program?

- Great savings to you on future college costs (over 75% off regular tuition)

Florida Public University	\$200 per credit hour
Community College	\$105 per credit hour
Private University	\$1,000 per credit hour
<b>Dual Enrollment (St. Thomas University)</b>	<b>\$60 per credit hour</b>

- 3 credit course = \$180 vs \$600
- 4 credit course = \$240 vs \$800

## **What are the benefits of enrolling in St. Thomas University's Dual Enrollment program?**

- Transferable credits when you attend college (will depend on the college you attend and their policy)..Credits will transfer to any Florida public college or university.
- Graduate early from college or alleviate course work
- Automatic admission to St. Thomas University (upon completion of undergraduate admission's form) and receive up to 50% tuition discount.

# Important Dual Enrollment Deadlines

September 17, 2021- New students must apply  
September 24, 2021- All students must register for courses  
October 22, 2021- Payment for all dual enrollment courses
